Coronavirus Update - 5

In a statement released by the Government today, two cases of novel coronavirus have been detected in India, one in New Delhi and the other in Telangana.

The statement added that the person from Delhi had travelled to Italy and the other had visited Dubai. Both patients are reported stable and are being closely monitored.

The government is very aggressively and very competently monitoring the situation. To tackle the virus, 15 new laboratories have been made operational.

Passengers landing in India continue to be scanned across 21 designated airports in the country for a possible exposure to the novel coronavirus.

As per the travel advisory issued by the Government, people showing symptoms may be quarantined for 14 days on arrival to India.
