Coronavirus Update - 10

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases across India has gone up to 110. With three patients from Rajasthan cured, the total number of patients freed from the coronavirus has reached 13 in India.

To prevent the spread of COVID -19, the Mumbai Police has prohibited all types of group tours in the city till March 31, 2020.

In Pune, authorities are likely to impose a lockdown as the district has recorded the highest number of positive cases in the country at 15.

In Delhi social and cultural gatherings involving more than 50 people will not be allowed to take place.

Andaman & Nicobar administration has suspended all tourism till March 26, 2020.

Section 144 has been imposed in Kangra District in the Indian State of Himachal Pradesh which prohibits assembly of five or more people.
