Coronavirus Destination Update

The Governments in the Indian sub-continent have responded rapidly to the crisis, but the task remains daunting with surge in cases with resumption of economic activities. New guidelines and protocols are being issued in destinations to gear up for the new normal.

NEPAL

Nepal's lockdown is effective until June 14 amid a surge in the number of coronavirus cases. All domestic and international flights remain suspended through June 30. Although the date of the resumption of the aviation service is still unknown, the Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal (CAAN) has issued fresh guidelines to operate flight services, airport and ground services during the coronavirus emergency with the provision of status card for the domestic passengers and crew members, and passenger locator card for international flights. The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 4,364 cases, with 485 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 15 deaths are reported due to the virus.
