Coronavirus Destination Update

As countries gradually exit lockdown to reopen economies, the region is striving to find a balance to control the spread of coronavirus.

NEPAL

The Nepal government decided to relax the ongoing lockdown in a phase-wise manner, allowing most of the economic activities to operate by following certain health protocol including social distancing measures. However, all domestic and international passenger flights to and from the country will remain suspended until July 5, owing to surge in new cases.

Effective this week, the Department of Immigration has resumed services for all valid visa holders whose visas were valid through at least March 21, 2020.

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 7,177 cases, with 1163 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 20 deaths are reported due to the virus.
