Coronavirus Destination Update

NEPAL

Nepal tourism announced the first version of the Operational guideline for tourism stakeholders. See <u>Operational Guideline with Health Protocol for Tourism</u> for details.

The Nepalese government has partially eased the lockdown in a phase-wise manner, allowing most of the economic activities to resume amid safety protocols. Although domestic and international passenger flights to and from the country remain suspended until July 5, it is expected the government would allow resumption of flights.

The country has seen an ongoing peaceful protest against the government's handling of the crisis. The protesters' demands have focused on financial accountability and greater testing capacity

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 10,728 cases, with 2,334 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 24 deaths are reported due to the virus.
