Coronavirus Destination Update

There is gradual resumption of economic activity in the region with added precautions and decision-making is being reviewed in keeping with the epidemiological pattern of the disease. With ease of restrictions, the coronavirus cases have continued to rise in the region and we are seeing new guidelines being readied in destinations to gear up for the new normal.

NEPAL

Nepal's lockdown is into its tenth week and the government has extended the nationwide lockdown until June 14 amid a surge in the number of coronavirus cases. The government has also decided to suspend all domestic and international flights until June 30. The airport authorities have used the time to give the facility a facelift by expanding parking and the runway. TIA has added and upgraded space in both the international and domestic terminals to conform to WHO guidelines for physical distancing and other coronavirus prevention measures.

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 2,300 cases, with 252 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 9 deaths are reported due to the virus.
