Coronavirus Destination Update

The Indian subcontinent has seen spike in coronavirus cases in the past few weeks, but the low fatality ratio offers hope. The region remains steadfast on the path to reopen economies and restoration of public life.

INDIA

Over the past month, since the central government ushered in the phase of reopening of the economy and restoration of public life and normalcy through what was called “Unlock” (as opposed to ‘lockdown’), the government issued fresh guideline for unlock 2.0 phase that will be in effect till 31 July.

After a shutdown of more than 100 days, the Taj Mahal and all other heritage monuments across the country are set to reopen from July 6. Domestic flights and passenger trains have already been allowed in a limited manner, their operations will further be expanded in a calibrated manner.

In view of rising Covid-19 cases, most existing curbs such as the ban on reopening schools and colleges, as well as multiplexes, gyms, bars, and the operation of Metro rail services, have been maintained. Lockdown will continue to be in force in containment zones.

The coronavirus case count in India now stands at 6,25,544 cases, with 3,79,891 recovered according to latest health ministry figures. 18,213 people have died due to the virus.
