Coronavirus Destination Update

NEPAL

The Nepal Government extended the lockdown till July 22 in its current form. It allows for limited business and activities with stricter requirements to follow social distancing guidelines, running of private vehicles on odd and even number basis, and passenger limitations. Nepal border areas and all domestic and international passenger flights to and from the country remain suspended until July 22, except for emergency flights.

In order to galvanize the tourism economy, Nepal Tourism Board has requested the government to ease travel restrictions and reopen the country for tourists from August 1.

The coronavirus case count in Nepal now stands at 16,423 cases with 7,752 recoveries according to latest health ministry figures. 35 deaths are reported due to the virus.
